Dear Parents

Return to School P4-7:

From Monday 15th, Mrs English will be in the playground before school starts (from 8:45) to remind each class to remain in their bubble and not mix when in the playground.

Class 2 will continue to enter the school via their classroom door where they will wash hands upon entering and exiting the building. If your child needs their own soap, please send it in labelled on Monday.

The class bubbles will continue in school, which means each class will stay in their own area during playtime and lunchtime and have allocated tables in the lunch hall. Schools bags and items from home should be kept to an absolute minimum - water bottles, packed lunch, and snack. 2m distance should be kept between the teachers and pupils and the teachers will wear a face mask when working closely with any children.
